---RESOLUTION---

WHEREAS, the 2017 Fiscal Budget of the Freehold Township Fire District No. 1 has been rejected by the voters of the District in a duly held election on February 18, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-78.5b and N.J.A.C. 5:31-2.4(h), when the budget of the fire district is rejected at the annual election of the district, the governing body of the local unit is required to prepare and adopt the budget, after consultation with the Freehold Township Fire District No. 1, to determine the amount which is necessary to be appropriated in such budget and to certify to the Division of Local Government Services, the total amount so determined; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator has consulted with representatives of the Freehold Township Fire District No. 1 regarding the amount necessary to be appropriated; and

WHERAS, the Governing Body held a public hearing and considered the needs of the public; and

WHEREAS; the Governing Body has determined that the reductions set forth herein can be effectuated without a reduction in services or negatively impacting the residents of Freehold Township

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the following determination is hereby made:

1. The original tax levy on the ballot for the base budget:

\$ 1,136,000.00

2. The amount of reduction to the tax levy for the base budget: \$239,500.00

3. The amount of tax levy being certified for the base budget: \$896,500.00

4. Specific line item reductions are as follows:

- 5. The Governing Body finds based upon a review of all data provided by the Freehold Township Fire District No.1, communications of the Township Administrator with representatives of the Fire District, the public hearing and consideration of the public need that the reductions set forth herein can be effectuated without a reduction in services or negatively impacting the residents of Freehold Township for the following reasons:
 - a. \$4,500 reduction in Administration for Professional fees which brings it in line with past experience and the comments by the district that it anticipates less professional fees in 2017.
 - b. The proposed salaries and payroll tax costs have been removed for the hiring of paid personnel, amounting to a \$99,000 cut for salaries and fringe benefits.
 - c. \$5,000 reduction from both the Utilities budget and the Mobile Phone budget to in line with spending totaling \$10,000.
 - d. \$21,000 reduction from Other Non-bondable expenses, which is a 17% cut in that line item. The proposed County Radio Trunk System project for the District is not ready for a 2017 rollout.
 - e. \$10,000 reduction from computer expense for the purchase of new IT equipment, however, the IT Maintenance Budget in the Administration section will be left unchanged.
 - f. \$15,000 reduction from the Education and Training Budget calling for decreased travel and lodging expenses for education and training by sending less members to the national convention in 2017.

- 6. Application of an additional \$80,000 for a total of \$115,000 from Fund Balance to Revenues with the suggestion that the District implement a capital asset and debt service program, while leaving sufficient surplus in the Fund Balance as a percentage of the tax levy.
- 7. In an effort to demonstrate the individual budget reductions to various items, a breakdown of the adjustments has been provided in Attachment A of this resolution.
- 8. The Fire District Budget, as adopted by the Governing Body, shall not become effective until the Director of the Division of Local Government Services has approved same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution along with three certified copies of the Fire District No. 1 Budget be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1., the Freehold Township Administrator, the Freehold Township Director of Finance, the Freehold Township Tax Collector and the Freehold Township Tax Assessor.
