The 2019 Budget reflects administrative expenses \$12,650 higher than in 2018 representing a 9.74% increase. The Cost of Operations and Maintenance budget reflects a \$179,150 or 29.64%, increase. Insurance expenses have increased \$42,500 due to increases in membership. Utilities, mostly electric, are expected to increase \$7,000 or 20%. However, cell phone expenses are being reduced \$4,000 due to lack of use. Truck Repairs and Maintenance, Operating Supplies, Building Maintenance, and Equipment Testing represent significant increases due to the fact that the 2017 and 2018 Budgets were defeated by the voters and subsequently the Township Committee set the Budget at what possibly were unrealistic levels for proper operations. As a result, the District neglected routine maintenance in all areas due to lack of funding. It is difficult for the District to compare the Budget since the Township Committee actually set the budget levels.

 - In 2018, the amount to be raised by taxation of \$774,200 equating to 2.30 cents per \$100 of value translates to a Fire District tax of \$92.47 on an average residential unit of \$402, 041. In 2019 the amount to be raised by taxation is \$1,641,000 which translates to a tax of \$188.56 on average residential unit. Major increases are attributed to special-meeting approval of \$480,000 of capital equipment offset by \$80,000 of Restricted Fund Balance utilized, at the 2018 Annual Fire Election, a referendum was approved to purchase a \$1.3 million tanker truck and to issue debt for the purchase with an estimate of Debt Service in year 1 of \$190,000 and the appropriation for LOSAP has increased by \$25,000 in order to ensure in the future that the Fund is solvent considering the relative age of a significant number of volunteer members.
