 - Cost of Operations is up \$25,000 or 3.10% due to increased appropriations for cell phone communication, added education and testing and building maintenance.
 - LOSAP estimate is based on increase and new members.

In the district is located the single largest retail in Monmouth County (a large shopping mall) and a sizable electrical substation.

Amount to be raised by taxation in 2016 is \$1.085.000 compared to 2015 of \$1.085.000. The tax rate in 2016 is $.0330 \ (3.30e)$ per \$100 assessed valuation vs. $.0330 \ (3.30e)$ per \$100 assessed valuation in 2015. Unrestricted surplus utilized in 2016 of \$78.500 which is less than in 2015.

The proposed budget will not increase the tax rate. The projected impact on the 2017 budget is minimal since the proposed balance of Unreserved Fund Balance (after utilization in the 2016 Budget) is deemed to be adequate to support the subsequent year's budget.

The Fire District's 2016 amount to be raised by taxation is in compliance with existing Property Tax Levy Cap.

The Amount of \$50,000 is being appropriated for Capital Improvements as approved by the voters of the District on December 9, 2015 of \$50,000. There is no debt service in the budget this year. An Average residential unit with an assessed valuation of \$375,365 will pay a fire tax of \$123.87 in 2016 compared to \$123.87 in 2015, no increase.
