Mr. Lagravenis suggested to the Board that they give a \$5 drug test upon an individual completing an application, which would save the Board money. Mr. Lagravenis will get the Board information on said drug test. Mr. Lagravenis left the meeting at 8:35pm.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to go back into executive session for the purpose of discussing a personnel matter at 8:35pm.

Mr. Lengyel provided the Board with four quotes for the AC units.

Motion was made by Mr. Lengyel to hire Jersey All Shore Heating & Air Conditioning, LLC to Install Two (2) Air Handler Units and Two (2) 5-Ton Compressors for the District, in the amount of \$13,800.

Second: Mr. Story 4-0 all in favor

Mr. Lengyel discussed his concern with the Board regarding the importance of planning for future apparatuses needed.

Mr. Toutounchi spoke with Chief about anyone coming to calls barefoot and noted that it is a hazard to come in without shoes.

Mr. Fogarty read his October 9th Treasurer Report into record.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to transfer \$14,000 from Ocean First money market to Ocean First checking account and pay the bills in the amount of \$13,514.32.
