Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to transfer \$25,000 from Ocean First money market to Ocean First checking account and pay the bills in the amount of \$18,400.67.

<u>Insurance</u>: Mr. Fogarty mentioned that Liberty Mutual is giving their annual audit to update the members list. Mr. Story and Mr. Horan said they could meet with the agent.

Motion was made by Mr. Lengyel to surplus all of the first aid supplies in the closet and donate them to Freehold First Aid, off of the recommendation of Anthony Gandolfo, Nicole, Rachel Mitzelman.

Roll call vote: 5-0 all in favor

Physicals: Mr. Story suggested that the Board hold off on this discussion until after the election.

Harassment Class: Scheduled for Wednesday, April 17th, 7pm, at Smithburg. Everyone must be in attendance, with an exception of those who are Freehold Township employees and have completed their harassment class. Freehold First Aid will be joining us. Mr. Story will invite District No. 2 and the Borough, possibly split the cost of the class. No one objected. Chief Reifer will let members know at their next meeting.

Election: Mr. Toutounchi reminded the Chief that members are not to be hanging around the voters during the election.
