**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
OF FIRE DISTRICT NO.1 FREEHOLD TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING
THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR
PUBLIC USE PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A.40A:11-36**

WHEREAS; The Board of Fire Commissioners owns one model year 2003 HME pumper fire engine which the Chief of the Freehold Township Independent Fire Company has certified is no longer needed for fire suppression/ protection purposes within the District and may be declared to be excess property by the Board; and

WHEREAS; The Board has been advised that the estimated fair market value of said apparatus exceeds the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS; N.J.S.A.40A:11-36 (1) provides that if the estimated fair value of the property to be sold exceeds 15 percent of the bid threshold, it shall be sold at public sale to the highest bidder; and

WHEREAS; Notice of the date, time and place of the public sale together with a description of the items to be sold and the conditions of sale shall be published in the official newspaper and such sale shall be held not less than seven nor more than 14 days after the latest publication of the notice thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No.1 Freehold Township that the 2003 HME Fire Engine Pumper is hereby declared to be excess property no longer needed for fire protection purposes within the Fire District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sale shall be by sealed bids to be received commencing at 6:00 p.m. on July 9, 2019 at the offices of the Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District No.1 Freehold Township Schanck and Stillwells Corner Road Freehold Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said apparatus shall be sold to the highest bidder in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(1) et. seq. subject to the following specified conditions of sale:

[1] The apparatus is being sold in an "AS IS" condition with no warranties or guaranties of any nature regarding its fitness for particular use or purpose.

[2] The sale is with a reserve of rights to the Board of Fire Commissioners to accept or reject any and all bids as the Board may deem to be in its best interests.

[3] The minimum bid price is \$2,750.00.

[4] A certified or cashiers check in the amount of 10% of the amount bid must be submitted with the bid at the time of bid receipt. This deposit will be nonrefundable for the highest bidder.

[5] The transfer of title must occur within ten (10) days of the date of bid receipt..

[6] Payment of the purchase price shall be by certified or Bank Cashiers check made payable to the Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District No.1 Freehold Township.
