Motion was made by Mr. Story to waive the reading of the resolution and for Mr. Stankiewicz to summarize said resolution.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to adopt the 2020 Budget Resolution for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Roll call was taken, and the Commissioners present at the meeting were John Toutounchi, Andrew Story, Michael Fogarty and Stephen Lengyel. Also in attendance were Board Attorney-Joseph Youssouf and Board Secretary-Rachel Davis.

Motion was made by Mr. Lengyel to approve the minutes from the December 23, 2019, regular and special meetings.

Treasurer's Report: Commissioner Fogarty read the January 21, 2020 Treasurer's Report into record.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to transfer \$7,100.00 from Ocean First money market to Ocean First checking and to pay the bills in the amount of \$7,026.61.

<u>Correspondence</u>: Mr. Fogarty mentioned a letter from the Freehold Township Tax Assessor regarding Georgia Road. Mr. Lengyel will take care of. Mr. Fogarty will give the Smithburg letter to the President.

Buildings: BC Mason came and did Georgia Road.

Old Business:

Councilman Mike DiBenedetto from the Borough of Freehold contacted Mr. Toutounchi regarding doing a shared service agreement, having 70 members use the Board's Fit Test machine for \$500 per year. They will purchase their own fit mask adapter. Mr. Youssouf said their insurance should pay for damages on their property; Board's insurance will pay for damages on Board's property. Board discussed, and all members were in agreement to do a shared service agreement, at no charge.
