Regular Meeting

October 11, 2022

Chairman John Toutounchi called the regular workshop meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners to order at 7pm, and Chief Craig Haas led the flag salute. Roll call was taken, and the Commissioners present at the meeting were John Toutounchi, Andrew Story, Michael Fogarty and Stephen Lengyel. Board Secretary-Rachel Davis was also present at the meeting.

Chairman Toutounchi asked for a moment of silence to remember Ex-Fire Commissioner and Firefighter Ray Flood.

Chairman Toutounchi suspended the regular order of business to open the floor for Architect-Jack Purvis, who reviewed his specs and discussed building plans with the Board. Mr. Lengyel agreed to represent the Board at the meeting.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to accept the plans from Architect Jack Purvis and to also have him advertise in the newspaper.

Treasurer's Report: Commissioner Fogarty read the October 11, 2022 Treasurer's Report into record.

Insurance: Mr. Fogarty noted that the three vehicles that were in an accident all went through claims, and he received checks for two of them. Once all the parts come in, they will go out for repair.

Mr. Toutounchi put a claim in for the helmet that was run over, and he will wait and see if they insure it.

<u>Buildings</u>: Commissioner Lengyel reported that:

- He talked to Joe for the roof repairs at Georgia Road. They will start with the smaller project first to determine what needs to be done.
- He will fix the light switch, arrange to have cages over the thermostat and buy some bulbs.
- Mr. Story said Mr. Burmeister had checked the salt at Georgia Road.

- All gear was checked and cleaned.
- Dollar amount is needed for 87 services.
- He will finish up his budget by the end of the week. The Board said to plan for October 25th meeting to discuss.

- 2nd Asst. Frank Santore said that the CAD system was updated, but something happened to the servers, so they might need to get reprogrammed.
