Regular Meeting

January 9, 2024

Chairman John Toutounchi called the regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners to order at 6:00pm and led the flag salute. Roll call was taken, and the Commissioners present at the meeting were John Toutounchi, Andrew Story, Michael Fogarty and Phil Engel. Board Secretary-Rachel Davis also joined the meeting via teleconference.

Treasurer's Report: Commissioner Fogarty read the January 9, 2024 Treasurer's Report into record.

Motion was made by Mr. Fogarty to transfer \$40,000 from Ocean First Money Market to Ocean First checking and to pay the bills in the amount of \$39,761.83.

Mr. Fogarty updated the Board on the Bond Anticipation Note (BAN).

Mr. Fogarty advised President Keane that he had requested the Fire Company's audit for 2021 from Treasurer Chris Puccio.

Mr. Toutounchi advised President Keane that the cameras and controlled access are still a work in progress at Smithburg. All access will be transferred over, and key fobs are working for their office.

Chief's Report:

Chief Haas updated the Board on the Line Officers' responsibilities and three engineers. Chief Haas also discussed gas meters as surplus items. Commissioner Fogarty asked for written information on the surplus items. Chief Haas also shared his opinion on the difference in the gear options.

Mr. Toutounchi suspended the regular order of service at 6:27pm so the Board can listen to an Alpine Software demo.

Board Attorney-Mr. Braslow joined the meeting via teleconference at 7:00pm.

New Business: Mr. Toutounchi noted that in March they will be restriping the parking lot for \$2,600 as well as obtaining removable signs to be helpful in the future.

Commissioner Story gave another update on the Indianapolis trip. He is researching flight information.

<u>Legal</u>: Mr. Braslow reminded everyone that a closed session discussion is considered confidential, and the minutes of said closed session should only be revealed when the matter is resolved. If there is any breach of the confidentiality, it is a potential criminal offense.

Mr. Braslow reiterated the responsibilities of Board members, which is to insure fire protection for the residents and taxpayers of the fire district. This includes providing the appropriate manpower, appropriate equipment and assets. The Board has extensive amount of authority, but ultimately, the buck stops with the Board.

Commissioner Fogarty mentioned that the audit for last year is complete. He will upload to DCA and then the budget will be considered adopted.

Mr. Story wished luck to Chief Haas and is looking forward to a good 2024.

Commissioner Story noted for the record that he received a total of four (4) petitions for commissioner. Mr. Braslow noted that the deadline is the 19th, and he will take a look at them.
